CARE PLAN FOR THE DYING CHILD (CPDC) • The CPDC aims to support compassionate, coordinated and best-practice care, but does not replace clinical judgement • Care outlined in the CPDC must be altered if it is not clinically appropriate for the individual child/young person Steps to Initiate the Care Plan for the Dying Child (CPDC) *Can be initiated by nursing staff
